Rake plie to curb or edge of road
(DO NOT RAKE INTO STREET OR DITCH)
Bags must be untied

SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING GUIDELINES

- Solid waste and Recycling is picked up every week on Tuesday and Wednesday and shall be out by 7am on your collection day.
- Solid waste shall be put in clear bags. Recycling shall be put in a separate clear bag. Bags are delivered to residents quarterly. Extra bags are available at the Town Hall for a fee.
- Solid waste and Recycling shall be placed at curb or roadside in two separate piles for easy identification for the crew to see. If using containers, they shall be identified by saying Solid waste or Recycling.
- Solid Waste and Recycling containers shall have a lid and handles (not handles cut into the container) with a maximum capacity of 40 gal. or 40 lbs.
- Bags shall be clear or transparent for easy identification with a maximum capacity of 30 gal. or 30 lbs.
- Containers in poor condition will be tagged for replacement (container will be thrown away next time if put out)
- Special pickup needed for large amount of Solid waste or remodeling projects. (call for a dumpster, small fee applies).
- Recycling is single stream (**ALL** cans, bottles, and paper recyclables can be comingled in **ONE** recycling bag or container).
- Cardboard that does not fit in bag or container shall be broken down and bundled for pickup.
- Large items and Appliances shall have a \$25 prepaid sticker affixed to the item for pickup. (If items are tagged for noncompliance and not promptly removed from the road, the Town will pick up the item the following week and bill the home owner or place the charge on the tax bill, along with an administrative fee.)
- Tires fee is \$3 per auto and light truck tire (\$5 on a rim) \$10 per medium truck tire cut in half (\$20 on a rim or not cut in half) \$25 per tractor tire cut into 4 sections (\$50 on a rim or not cut into 4 sections).
- A tag will be placed on your collection items if you do not comply with Town of Madison collection procedures.
